Teams: Video and Audio

Before Entering A Meeting

After joining a Teams meeting but before entering, you will be brought to a video and audio options/preview screen.

- 1. To turn your camera on or off use the "Camera" button.
 - Next to this button is where you will also find the "Background filters" options.
- 2. Use the "Open device settings" button to access additional camera and microphone options.
- 3. To turn your microphone on or off use the "Microphone" button under the "Computer audio" section.
- 4. Use the "Open device settings" button to access additional camera and microphone options.



During A Meeting

If you are already in a Teams meeting and wish to change turn your camera or microphone on or off you can do so during the meeting.

- 1. To turn your camera on or off use the "Camera" button.
 - o If the full camera icon is visible, your camera is on.
 - o If the camera icon has a slash over it, your camera is off.
- If you hover over the button, you will see a private preview and be able to access the "Blur my background" and "More background effects" buttons.
- 3. To turn your microphone on or off use the "Microphone" button.
 - o If the full microphone icon is visible, your camera is on.
 - If the microphone icon has a slash over it, your camera is off.
 - i. Microsoft shortcut: Ctrl + Shift + M
 - ii. Mac shortcut: Cmd + Shift + M
